### **Board of Education Election and Candidates Forum**

Nutley, NJ—The League of Women Voters of the Nutley Area reminds all citizens that the Township of Nutley will hold a General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, including the election of three (3) members to the 9 member Board of Education. A candidate for the Board must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of the district the member represents for at least one year immediately preceding the member's election or appointment, must be able to read and write, must be registered to vote in the district, and not disqualified from voting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1. Polls are open from 6 am to 8 pm.

The League of Women Voters of the Nutley Area, as part of our commitment to informed and active participation in a democratic government, is sponsoring a candidates forum in collaboration with Nutley Association of American University Women, **November 1, 2018 at the Nutley Museum, 65 Church St., Nutley, NJ 07110 at 7:30 pm**. The League will submit 3 questions to the candidates for each of them to answer ahead of time. Their answers, as well as statements regarding why each person is running will be published and copies will be available at the forum. To vote in the General Election you must be registered to vote no later than October 16, 2018.

#### **Voting Registration Information:**

- Deadline: postmarked by October 16, 2018;
- Deadline to Apply by mail for Vote by Mail ballot: must be in County Clerk's office by October 30, 2018;
- Deadline to Apply in person for Vote by Mail ballot: 3:00 p.m. November 6, 2018 General Election Day.

Registered voters will receive a sample ballot in the mail. Sample ballots contain important information about what will appear on the ballot and the League urges voters to study their sample ballots carefully.
