

MATTIA COMMITTEE SEEKS NOMINATIONS AND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

The Virginius D. Mattia Memorial Committee has begun its 2020 selection process. The annual award is given to individuals or organizations who demonstrate the volunteer spirit of Dr. Mattia, former president of Hoffmann LaRoche who died an untimely death in 1971, through dedicated community service.

Nomination forms are available at the Library, the Parks and Recreation Building and Town Hall, but a letter with pertinent information on a nominee is acceptable. Anyone previously nominated is eligible, but updated nominations are helpful. Persons running for public office are not eligible during an election year.
